



I. BASIC PRINCIPLES AND CONDITIONS

A. Eligible Applicants

Students who meet the following application requirements and are graduates or senior students of a school equivalent to Turkish high schools can apply to our University's programs.

1-) Foreign nationals,

2-) Those who were Turkish citizens by birth but obtained permission to renounce Turkish citizenship from the Ministry of Interior, and those who can document that they have a Certificate of Use of Rights recognized by the Turkish Citizenship Law for their minor children registered in their document of renunciation of Turkish citizenship, (According to Article 7 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901, "(1) A child born in or outside of Turkey to a Turkish citizen mother or father within the unity of marriage is a Turkish citizen." Candidates who will apply for quotas from abroad should review the Turkish Citizenship Law),

3-) Those who acquired Turkish citizenship later by naturalization / dual nationals in this situation,

a) Turkish students who were continuing secondary education abroad before 01/02/2013 and completed the last three years of their secondary education (high school) in a foreign country except Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus (TRNC) (including those who completed their entire secondary education (high school) in Turkish schools opened under the Ministry of Education in a foreign country except TRNC) can apply for quotas from abroad,

b) Those who started secondary education abroad after 01/02/2013 and completed their entire secondary education (high school) in a foreign country except TRNC (including those who completed their entire secondary education (high school) in Turkish schools opened under the Ministry of Education in a foreign country except TRNC) can apply for quotas from abroad,

4) TRNC nationals who reside in TRNC and completed their secondary education (high school) in TRNC and have GCE AL exam results, and those who registered in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005-2010 and have or will have GCE AL exam results,

ARE ACCEPTED.

B. Ineligible Applicants

Those who have been expelled from a higher education institution in Turkey due to disciplinary action cannot apply for international student quotas.

Candidates applying for international student quotas must meet the specified registration requirements of the programs.

1-) Those who are Turkish citizens and have completed their entire secondary education in Turkey or TRNC,

2-) Those who are TRNC nationals (except those who have completed their entire secondary education in TRNC high schools and have GCE AL results, or those who registered in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005-2010 and have or will have GCE AL exam results),

3-) Dual nationals whose first nationality at birth is Turkish **as defined in item 2 of section A** (except those who meet the conditions in item 4 of section A),

4-) Dual nationals, one of whose nationalities is TRNC (except those who have completed their entire secondary education in TRNC high schools and have GCE AL results, or those who registered in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005-2010 and have or will have GCE AL exam results),

5-) Turkish citizens or dual nationals whose first nationality at birth is Turkish, as defined in item 2 of section A, who have studied in schools affiliated with embassies in Turkey or foreign high schools in Turkey,

ARE NOT ACCEPTED.





II. PRE-APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must meet at least one of the conditions specified in Table 1 below for the 2025-2026 academic year.

- h) BACCALAUREAT LIBANAIS: The test taken to study in Lebanese universities,
- i) BACCALAUREAT FRANÇAIS: The test taken to study in French universities,
- j) AL-SAHADA: The test taken to study in Syrian universities,
- k) AL TAHANAWİYYA: The test taken to study in Libya universities,,
- 1) GAOKAO: The test taken to study at universities in the People's Republic of China.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS FOR PRELIMINARY APPLICATION (Documents to be uploaded to the website)

Applications will be made online between July 11, 2025 - August 08, 2025

- 1) A maximum of <u>five</u> choices will be made.
- 2) A certified copy of high school diploma (documents must be in English or Turkish approved by the high school principal).
- 3) Those who have not yet received their diploma from high school need to upload a student certificate and a document showing their grade point average-CGPA.
- 4) A copy of passport or Official Identification Document-ID
- 5) Exam results for YÖS or other exams.

Note: Any application with missing documents will not be evaluated.

III. PRELIMINARY APPLICATION DATES AND PLACE

All applications will be received on <u>http://www.trabzon.edu.tr</u> between July 11, 2025 - August 08, 2025

IV. EVALUATION OF PRELIMINARY APPLICATIONS

Admission, placement and rejection decisions are entirely under the authority of Trabzon University. Trabzon University is free to fill or not fill the quotas. Fulfilling the application requirements does not guarantee admission.

The results will be announced on 27.08.2025 (at 23.59 at the latest) at http://www.trabzon.edu.tr/. An





individual result document will not be sent to the candidates.

Evaluation Criteria:

(1) Applications of candidates who do not meet the application requirements will not be evaluated.

(2) Evaluation and placement of applications are carried out by the Commission (Foreign Student Admission Commission (YUÖKK)) established by the Rector.

(3) Candidates can make a maximum of five choices from the announced quotas, which they have the right to apply for and indicate their order.

(4) The commission calculates the placement score by converting the scores of the exams in Annex Table 1 into a 100-point system. Placement scores are ranked from highest to lowest. In case of equality in placement scores, the candidate with the closest high school graduation date is first taken into consideration, and if there is still an equality, the candidate whose age is younger is taken into consideration.

In the placement process, firstly, international candidates are accepted according to their TR-YÖS results, which has been conducted by OSYM (Student Selection and Placement Centre) since 2023.

(5) Firstly, in case there are vacancies after placements made with the TR-YÖS score, the candidates will be evaluated based on the standardized scores they have obtained from equivalent exams (such as ABITUR, TQDK, SAT, ACT, GAOKAO, GCE AL, etc.) that have national and international validity as high school graduation and/or university entrance exams in other countries, or according to the equivalent exam scores converted into the hundred (100) system. The candidates will then be placed in a single program as main and reserve candidates according to their preference ranking within the quota.

(6) In case there are still vacancies, candidates will be placed based on their secondary education (high school) graduation scores.

(7) The number of candidates accepted into a program from the same country cannot exceed 20% of the available quota for that program. If there are no applications or if the quota is not filled for the allocated country/countries, the country limit will not be applied, and the unfilled quotas can be transferred to the quotas of other countries, or the country quotas can be removed, and the placement process will be carried out accordingly.

(8) For applications to the quotas for international students determined by YÖK in the Teaching and Law programs, specifically for these programs, candidates who were born Turkish citizens but lost their Turkish citizenship by obtaining permission from the Ministry of Interior in accordance with the Turkish Citizenship Law, candidates who document that they hold a blue card given to those who lost their Turkish citizenship upon their request, and dual nationals with one Turkish citizenship, at most 10% of the international student acceptance quota in these fields can be used.

(9) The final registrations of foreign students admitted to Trabzon University will be carried out by the Student Affairs Department on the specified dates. If the quotas are not filled after the completion of the final registration process (due to non-registration, vacant spots, or cancellations), then:

- a) Among the existing applications, candidates who have not been placed in any program may be reassigned according to the reserve order.
- b) The country limit will not be applied.

The evaluation and placement of candidates will be carried out by the Commission established in the Rectorate's Student Affairs Department where they applied.

Candidates can make up to five preferences, indicating their ranking, from the announced quotas they are eligible to apply for.

The number of candidates accepted into a faculty, school, conservatory, or vocational school from the same country will be placed in such a way that it does not exceed 20% of the total quota of the programs affiliated with that faculty, school, conservatory, or vocational school. If there are no applications or if the quota is not filled for the allocated country/countries, the unfilled quotas can be transferred to the quotas of other countries, or the country quotas can be removed, and the placement process will be carried out accordingly.

The evaluation and placement of candidates applying to programs that admit students through a special talent exam will be carried out according to the university's own principles and procedures on the dates determined by the





university. Accepted students must document that they have the financial means to continue their higher education at Trabzon University with an official document that has international validity.

According to the assessment results, students who qualify for registration must register within the dates specified by the Student Affairs Office with the necessary documents.

V. DEFINITE REGISTRATION DATES, DOCUMENTS, and TUITION FEES

1) REGISTRATION DATES

<u>The definite registrations</u> for those admitted to the university will be conducted by the Student Affairs Directorate of Trabzon University between September 1-5, 2025.

Registration dates for reserves: Those on the first reserve list can register between September 09-11, 2025,, while second reserves can register between September 15-17, 2025 if the first reserves do not register.

2) Definite registration documents.

- a) Exam result document (Turkish version certified by the Turkish Embassy or Consulate in their country) or YÖS exam result document.
- b) High school diploma (Turkish version certified by the Turkish Embassy or Consulate in their country). Transcript (Turkish version certified by the Turkish Embassy or Consulate in their country).
- c) Equivalency certificate indicating completion of secondary education equivalent to Turkish high schools (equivalency process conducted by the Turkish Embassy or Consulate in their country or by the Ministry of National Education).
- d) Copy of passport. 2 passport-sized photos (4.5x6 cm, taken within the last six months, front-facing).
- e) Document demonstrating Turkish language proficiency (not required from students graduating from schools affiliated with the Ministry of National Education of the Republic of Turkey).
- f) Certificate of civil registration for citizens of the Republic of Turkey or TRNC (obtained from the civil registry office).

3) Tuition fee

As determined by the Council of Ministers, the amount set for Turkish students is collected at three times the rate for First Education and twice the rate for Second Education.

Contribution fee and tuition fee payments are specified in the application and evaluation calendar.





VI. TURKISH PROFICIENCY

- 1) Candidates who are admitted to Higher Education programs whose medium of instruction is Turkish can start their education after enrollment **depending on the results obtained from the Turkish Language Proficiency Test to be conducted by our University TÖMER to receive Turkish education.** Turkish Language Proficiency levels are given in Table 2.
- 2) Candidates who have a score of C1 or C2 in the TRU Turkish Language Proficiency Test (TYS), which is conducted by Trabzon University TÖMER, start their education immediately.
- 3) Students who do not have a Turkish Language Proficiency Certificate or whose Turkish level is A1, A2, B1 and B2 will not be able to start their education. These students are considered to be on leave for one year to receive Turkish language education in the Turkish Language Teaching program conducted by Trabzon University Turkish Language Teaching Application and Research Center. During this period, students whose Turkish language level is C1 and C2 will start their education in the program they are placed in. Students whose Turkish language level is not sufficient are given an additional period of one year. Students who cannot document that their Turkish language level is sufficient at the end of the additional period are dismissed from the University with the decision of the relevant unit board of directors.
- 4) Students are obliged to submit their Turkish language proficiency certificates to the Registrar's Office before the registration dates specified in the academic calendar.
- 5) Turkish Proficiency Certificate is not required from students who have completed their entire high school education in a Turkish high school abroad or in a high school in Turkey.
